[†] According to LesCroart: "In a real sense, *Guilt* is both a prequel and sequel to *A Certain Justice*. The events of *A Certain Justice* happen chronologically between Parts IV and V of *Guilt*."

The books in the Dismas Hardy column are legal thillers (but not the first two books, (*Dead Irish* and *The Vig*). Those first two books, along with the Glitsky and Hunt books, the author has said, are crime novels or crime thrillers.

The Dismas Hardy series begins in the mid-point of Hardy's life. Although he has already been a cop and a lawyer, life has been tough, and in the first two books he is just trying to adjust to his past. He works as "just a bartender" at the Little Shamrock - where he becomes a part owner... for the rest of the series.

Frannie is introduced in the first book and we learn how she became his 2nd wife.

Abe Glitsky, then a Jewish African-Amercan SFPD homicide inspector, also appears in the very first book and in most, if not all, of the 26 novels. In three books, he is the lead character and Dismas Hardy is just a minor figure, a friend). At some point he is promoted to the position of Lieutenant in charge of the homicide detail. In later books, after the election of Wes Farrell as DA, he leaves the SFPD to work as an investigator for the District Attorney's office.

In the 3rd book, *Hard Evidence*, Hardy returns to the practice of law as a prosecutor, but ends up as a defense lawyer. Also in this book, David Freeman, a well respected defense lawyer is introduced. He is a continuing partner with Hardy in quite a few of the books.

The Wyatt Hunt Club books start with some background on Wyatt's life and how he got into the private investigator business (with a bit of help from an attorney working at the Hardy firm). Dismas is always a very minor character in these books, and, like many in the PI book-world, they are written in the first person.

All the characters age in real time. For example, Dismas is roughly 36 in the first book and roughly 65 in *Poison*.
